Since its inception, the Take Note! Antonia Brancia Memorial Scholarship has been awarded to four eastern Connecticut students pursuing undergraduate degrees at Eastman School of Music, Temple University, Clark University and the University of Connecticut.

The scholarship serves as an important connection between Take Note! members and future generations of musicians, and as a memorial to a dear friend.
